

## Filming and Photography Protocol

Protocol for Filming or Photographing games at CDNL league or cup matches The Chelmsford & District Netball League are committed to respecting and protecting our players and umpires. These guidelines have been drawn up to help you ensure that you are adhering to CDNL's rules on recording a game or part of a game. Ensuring that all who play or officiate are safeguarded and protected in line with England Netball's safeguarding policy on the taking and use of photographs and recorded images of young people.

- 1. Identify the match you wish to film or photograph, make sure you have enough time to contact all the relevant parties.**
- 2. You must ask the team captains of both teams and both umpires for permission to film. You will need to give the team captains time to consult with their team.**
- 3. You must also ask the team captains and officials involved in games in the vicinity, who could possibly come into shot. So, both teams and umpires from courts adjacent to the identified game.**
- 4. Once you have approval from all concerned you should ask permission from the committee at least 48 hours prior to the game taking place and attach all the written proof/evidence you have of approval from all the possible involved parties. **Once the committee is satisfied that all parties that could be affected are in agreement with the filming, they will give their approval and filming can go ahead with that game only.**

Failure to follow these guidelines will result in the committee not being able to give approval and the infringing team will be deemed to have fallen foul of rule 4(h) and may incur a penalty or a fine in line with rule 40.
